



I-35 Stakeholder Working Group Overview

Project Background

The I-35 Capital Improvement Program (I-35 CAIP) is an effort to develop mobility solutions for I-35 within the Austin region. Goals of the I-35 CAIP include optimizing the existing facility, improving operations throughout the corridor, increasing capacity while minimizing the need for additional right-of-way, improving east-west connectivity, enhancing safety, improving compatibility with neighborhoods and enhancing bicycle, pedestrian and transit options. Downtown Austin is a key focus area of the I-35 CAIP.

Goal of the Stakeholder Working Group

To foster and encourage an informed regional dialogue about conceptual solutions along I-35 through downtown Austin.

Member Responsibilities

The “building block” nature of the planned Stakeholder Working Group meetings (each meeting builds upon previous meetings) makes it very important that members regularly attend and actively participate in meetings. For this reason, members are asked to:

- Provide essential, substantive input through participation in regular group discussions to inform the development of I-35 improvements through downtown.
- Communicate your organization’s needs, ideas and perspective.
- Report back to your organization with timely, accurate information regarding the I-35 CAIP and the options being considered through downtown.
- Attend a minimum of 75% of group meetings.
- Avoid missing two consecutive meetings.
