COMMUNITY INVITED TO OPEN HOUSE ON PROPOSED I-35 IMPROVEMENTS IN SOUTH AUSTIN

WHAT: I-35 Operational Improvements Open House

AUSTIN — The Texas Department of Transportation, in cooperation with the city of Austin, will conduct an open house to discuss two I-35 improvement projects:

- I-35 operational improvements in the vicinity of William Cannon Drive (Approximate limits: Stassney Lane to William Cannon Drive)
- I-35 operational improvements in the vicinity of Oltorf Street (Approximate limits: Woodward Street to Woodland Avenue)

The proposed projects would include construction of auxiliary lanes and U-turn bridges, reconfiguration of access ramps, and other frontage road and intersection improvements. All improvements would be constructed entirely in TxDOT's existing right-of-way; no additional right-of-way would be required. Project team members will be available to discuss the proposed improvements and answer questions. No formal presentation will be given and attendees are invited to come-and-go at their convenience.
